#### ■ RACHEL, THE UFO CAPITAL OF THE WORLD

Located along the Extra-terrestrial Highway, approximately 150 miles north of Las Vegas, this small town with just 100 inhabitants is a regular location for fans of UFO's. Like many of Nevada's towns, Rachel was once a mining town which closed over 20 years ago. The first UFO spotting was in 1989 and since then the town has been bustling with visitors. With unique UFO photos, desert dunes and a famous alien burger to try at the bar and restaurant named the Little ALieTm... (pronounced "Alien"), a visit to Rachel oozes family-fun and exclusive experiences; you don't have to be a UFO fanatic to enjoy this attraction.



#### ■ GHOST TOWN OF RHYOLITE

The secluded Rhyolite is classed as one of the best ghost towns in America. Situated on the eastern edge of Death Valley, Rhyolite was established in 1903 as a mining town during the gold rush but was abandoned in 1920. Since this time, no one has lived in the town. The general store, train station, bank and jail still stand in the deserted town.

#### ■ SLOPE INTO THE TIGER'S NEST

A New luxury lodge, nestled in the heart of the Swiss Alps in central Valais, has just opened. Named after Blütn's iconic temple, Tiger's Nest is a contemporary alpine lodge 1,550m up the mountain, in the east of Les 4 Vallées. Travelling time is just two hours by car from Geneva and three from Zurich.

Owned by a Hong Kong-based British family, the four storey lodge is furnished in a luxurious East meets West contemporary style. Featuring five beautifully appointed double bedrooms including, it enjoys spectacular views of the Matterhorn range of mountains.

On hand is a dedicated in-house team that includes a host, chef, driver and ski concierge - will provide the highest levels of service.

The area offers superb and reliable snow conditions with six ski lifts within a 12 minute drive of the house. Skiers can also easily access other parts of Les 4 Vallées - Nendaz, La Tzoumaz and Verbier.

Prices start from CHF 2,900pp (approx. £1,986), based on 10 adults sharing on a one week basis.
